Sollers Consulting will be in the newly minted Officyna building in Gdańsk, where the tenant leases approx. 1,100 sq m of office space. About Officyna

Officyna is a two-stage investment being developed in Gdańsk's Wrzeszcz district. Together the two buildings will supply over 12,300 sq. m of office space. The first stage, that will host the Sollers Consulting office, was commissioned at the end of August 2019. It is an intimate, five-storey office and service building located at Grunwaldzka Avenue, that perfectly matches the character of the district. It is a continuation of the existing buildings, but its modern architecture brings a definite revival to the frontage of the main artery of the Tricity. On the ground floor, service units have been designed (their total area is nearly 900 sq. m), accessible from both the main road and the building lobby. The upper floors contain office spaces, totalling to nearly 4,200 sq. m, and a terrace on the fourth floor that is a distinctive element of the building. The transaction was mediated by Savills.

Officyna was designed by the APA Wojciechowski Architekci studio. The building is certified under the LEED scheme (it is planned to achieve Gold level), and thus meets the requirements of sustainable, energy-efficient construction. Currently, the development of the second stage of the investment is underway - the planned date of commissioning is early 2021.
